Uldis Zarins is the Head of Strategic development at the National Library of Latvia and Vice President of Latvian Library Association. He has a Masters degree in Library and information science from the University of Latvia. He has been working at the National Library of Latvia since 2009, first as the head of digital library and now as the head of strategic development. During his tenure at the National Library he has overseen creation of the National Digital Library of Latvia and development and implementation of National Library's strategy for 2014-2018, which re-imagines the library in the context of the new Castle of Light. He is one of the co-authors of national strategies for libraries and digital heritage for 2014-2020. He is an expert in copyright and represents Latvian libraries in IFLA Committee on Copyright and other Legal Matters and EBLIDA Expert group on Information Law.

His professional interests include library digitisation and digital services, library policy, evaluation of library activities, as well as future developments of libraries. He is an elected member of Europeana Association Members Council, thus representing both Latvia and library sector in Europeana.
