Anders Söderbäck is responsible for IT and systems development at Stockholm university library. His focus for the past ten years has been on management, strategy and organization in the library sector. He has played an integral part in developing Stockholm university library into a change orientated organization with a big focus on open science. He has also been involved in promoting open data and open source library systems on both national and international level, as well as writing one of the first swedish collective licensing agreements to make available digitized research publications from Stockholm university.

Before his position at Stockholm university library, Anders worked at the National Library of Sweden with coordination and strategy for the swedish union catalogue Libris, as well as the Bibsam national licensing consortia. In 2008 he part of the team that made Libris the first library union catalogue published as linked open data om the web. For the past six years, he has been a member of the executive committee of the Swedish Library Association.

As part of the EBLIDA executive committee, Anders intends to push for a copyright legislation that is beneficial to making research and culture open to the european public. He is also interested in promoting EBLIDA as an important and organization for european libraries.
